Subject: All Plan Letter 24-004: Quality Improvement and Health Equity Transformation Requirements

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) recently issued <u>All Plan Letter (APL) 24-004</u>, "Quality Improvement and Health Equity Transformation Requirements." We are sharing a summary of this APL with you to ensure you are aware of the information, and you can apply the information to your practice or facility operations, where appropriate.

APL 24-004 notifies managed care plans (MCPs) such as Blue Shield of California Promise Health Plan about requirements for quality and health equity improvement.

APL summary

The APL advises MCPs to establish and implement a Quality Improvement and Health Equity Transformation Program (QIHETP), effective January 1, 2024. As part of their QIHETP, MCPs should:

- Align with various DHCS reports and measures, including the Comprehensive Quality Strategy
 Report, the Medi-Cal Managed Care Accountability Set, Technical Reports, the Health Disparties
 Report, the Services Report, Focus Studies, and the Encounter Data Validation Report.
- Complete a minimum of two Performance Improvement Projects.
- Participate in DHCS collaborations or initiatives that may improve quality and equity of care.
- Designate a Performance Improvement Lead and Regional Quality and Health Equity Teams.
- Report annually on how the plan addresses clinical quality of physical, behavioral health, access and engagement of providers, continuity and coordination of care, and member experience.
- Attend quarterly regional collaborative meetings.
- Align health equity goals with the DHCS Health Equity Framework within the Comprehensive Quality Strategy Report.
- Cooperate with annual DHCS member satisfaction surveys.
- Ensure subcontracters comply with quality and health equity improvement requirements.
