

HEDIS Provider Guide: Well Child Visits in the First 30 Months of Life (W30)

Measure Description

Using Correct Billing Codes

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•	Part I: Children who turned 15 months old	
	during the measurement year and who had at	
	least 6 well child visits with a primary care	
	physician (PCP) prior to turning 15 months.	

- Part II: Children who turned 30 months old during the measurement year and who had at least 2 well child visits with a PCP between 15th and 30th months of age.
- A well child visit consists of:
 - ✓ A health history
 - ✓ A physical developmental history
 - ✓ A mental developmental history
 - ✓ A physical exam
 - ✓ Health education/anticipatory guidance

Note: Well child visits **must** be at least 14 days apart to count.

Exclusions: Members in hospice.

How to Improve HEDIS® Scores

- Avoid missed opportunities by taking advantage of every office visit, including sick visits, to provide a well child visit, immunizations, developmental screening, lead testing, and topical fluoride for children.
- Make daycare physicals into well child visits by performing and documenting the required elements and submitting appropriate codes.
- Ensure medical records include the date that a health and developmental history and physical exam were performed, and what health education/anticipatory guidance was given.
- Use standardized templates in charts and in electronic medical records (EMRs) that allow checkboxes for standard counseling activities.
- Follow the Bright Futures®/American Academy of Pediatrics periodicity schedule.
- Schedule the next well child visit appointment at the end of the visit.
- Consider after hours/weekend hours to accommodate busy schedules.
- Telehealth visits are also acceptable to meet the measure requirements until December 31, 2024.
- Request a focused list of members who need to complete the well child visit series from your Blue Shield Promise Quality Program Manager.

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
